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Shot 1- (tilt up)

Shot of tower from down to up in morning time. Shot 2- (bird's eye)

Shot 3- (Pan)

Labyrinth → Unlike a simple maze, a labyrinth can only be solved in one way. When you think of mazes, you may picture many dead ends and winding paths, the same is not true within a labyrinth. The labyrinth only contains one winding road, which twists and turns but eventually leads you to an exit without any dead ends. This contains powerful symbolism for the soul's spiritual journey. These ancient 'mazes' are traditionally drawn with winding lines contained inside a circle.
